Restructuring of PM Awards Scheme




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- Established in 2006 to recognize extraordinary work by Districts/Organizations in Central and State Governments.




2nd Restructuring

To encourage constructive competition, innovation and instrumentalization of best practices.





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Key Points

1. Register compulsorily between **1st October to 15th November, 2025.**
 - a. Very short & convenient registration process
 - b. Separate registration for the districts - For Holistic category, each Aspirational Block and each Innovation to be submitted
 - i. Use mobile numbers for User ID creation, considering future tracking/updation of application forms under distinct categories.
 - ii. Specifically, as the ABP data for each Block will be provided by distinct administrative block.
2. The Nomination forms are objective, factual and evidence based.
3. Please provide relevant supporting documents, images, screenshots, or web links to substantiate the information provided in the respective section.
4. Recent relevant photograph(s) should be uploaded in jpeg or png format with size not exceeding 250 KB and should not be uploaded in collage format.
5. Quantitative Information under category I and category II of the award is being provided by the concerned Ministry/Department/Institutions. The fields are available in word and pdf files for information
